


Internet Traffic Light

To go the right way.










Term 1: Lesson 3 – Using Technology


We learnt to open 'Paint' with a double click. We are learning to: use the fill tool; use shape tools; select colours.




LO: - Use a computer keyboard

We opened 'Paint' with a double click. We are learning to: use the 'Text Tool'; use 'Caps Lock'; 'use 'Shift'.







Term 1: Lesson 5 – Using Technology

Term 2: Lesson 1 – How can we paint using computers?


